

Camp Chingachgook Alumni Association Meeting Minutes

Minutes from the May meeting were approved after a question about where the money for Steve Draper's memorial was coming from was answered by George; it will come from donations made in his honor. Chad Currin moved to approve, Gary August seconds, approved unanimously

**Updates:** All Alumni Council members are to be current in their dues as stated in the bylaws of the council.

Alumni Day is Saturday July 31, 2010. There will be a council meeting at 11 am followed by lunch. At 4:30 there will be an Alumni Dedication to Steve Draper of a chair and a brass plaque for the archives room. The council approved the expenditure of \$1000 for golf umbrellas with the association logo as a giveaway.

Also, Stacy Draper plans to make a donation to the Alumni Association to build a gazebo in Steve's memory.

**Buck Mountain Bugle:** The Bugle will go out to by the end of June. It will contain an appeal and a preview of the upcoming camp projects.

**Finance:** Bob Dorkin was absent but sent the following information; there is \$13,018.88 in the checking account (this amount includes the above mentioned Draper contributions) and \$5001.01 in the money market account. Postage for \$824.57 remains unpaid. George will look into. Gore for ~\$400 was just paid.

**Socials:** The New York City social is scheduled for October 23, 2010, Todd Nathan is going to organize it.

**Centennial:** DVD- what information do we need to provide to L&P and when do they need it? The question was raised as to having L&P to camp for Alumni Day to film. Also scheduling a meeting with them to design story board; the September Council meeting? George will call them.

The archives are light on pictures from the 1970's and 1980's.

**Miscellaneous:** Question as to who owns all of the archival material in the Draper's possession?  
Work weekend November 6-7 to continue on the archives and set up a timeline for the book.  
Alumni House: no movement on the acquisition

Chad presented the proposed home page layout. We discussed the look and feel and asked Chad to see about redoing it with more of the look and feel of the camp and the existing alumni site. GP asked that links to camp and to the CDY be included.

The CCAA has authorized the first ½ payment of \$3200 & CDY agreed to disburse the check which George is working on. Intellisites was waiting for disbursement to get underway.

Chad has volunteered to produce an e-newsletter for the site to be distributed to registered users. A discussion on registration took place and clarifications were made regarding the maintenance of the email list.

Once the site is underway Chad will lead discussion groups via GoToMeeting with Gary's assistance to get initial designs approved. Still on track for a fall "go-live".
